Dear Families,

Thank you to all our Families who supported our 'Mother's Day Sale' after school yesterday. The support we received was overwhelming and we raised £400 which will be used as a starter fund for the forthcoming PTA.

The Easter Raffle prizes have now been collated from your generous donations into over 20 Easter hampers. Prizes include tickets to Gulliver's theme park, gift vouchers for beauty treatments, Manchester City Merchandise, Life Leisure vouchers and much, much more. The hampers are displayed in the school office and the tickets will be on sale until Friday 11th April and will be drawn on this date in our celebration assembly.

On Monday banded letters will be sent out detailing your child's current attendance percentage. Being in school is important to your child's achievement, wellbeing, and wider development. Evidence shows that the students with the highest attendance throughout their time in school gain the best results. The register is taken at 8.50am and any children arriving after this time will receive a late mark. Registration time is a vitally important time where children settle for the day, reinforce previous learnt skills and teaching assistants take small groups to support them with their learning.

Also, on Monday, the popular Easter chicks, sold in aid of Francis House will be on sale both before and after school from the office. Chicks are £2 each or £3 for a 'fancy chick.'

You will receive extra-curricular club booking letters on Tuesday via email and we are pleased to be able to offer additional clubs such as Yoga and Performing arts as well as our usual offering. We are changing our booking system for Mr Stephenson's clubs. Initially, you will be sent a link to google forms and if you are successful in being allocated a place, Mrs Beer will email you, enabling you to make payment over School Money, as this is now our preferred payment method.

The weather looks set to be warmer next week, so please ensure your child comes to school with a water bottle and wearing the correct uniform. The children here at St Marys look wonderfully smart, reparenting our school so well! As a reminder, please ensure only black footwear is worn on non-PE days.

Tuesday 8th April is a very exciting day in school we have:

- Our Easter craft morning 9-10, parents are warmly welcomed into the classroom to enjoy a range of Easter crafts with their child.
