Dear Families,

I would like to extend a very warm welcome back to school following the Easter break. I hope you all had a wonderful holiday and it has been a joy to welcome our families back to school. The children look extremely smart and represent St Mary's wonderfully well, I greatly appreciate this commitment from our families. Please remember only all black footwear should be worn for school.

The guidance from Stockport Local authority, that we are required to follow, is that earrings must not be worn for PE and that taping is not acceptable. Please ensure all earrings are removed on PE days to ensure this guidance is adhered to. At other times only, small studs should be worn and other jewellery should not be worn for school.

I respectfully ask that all families ensure the office is fully informed of their child's meal pattern. For some children, this is changing unexpectedly and results in a cost to school from our meal provider. At £3.15 per meal this can have a significant impact to our budget.

Our next parent's morning (where parents are warmly welcomed into school is Friday 22nd May 9-10 am, there will be no celebration assembly on this date). It would be wonderful to see as many of you as possible for what is always a wonderful event here at St Mary's.

On Tuesday and Thursday next week, 'The Wild Roadshow' will be visiting St Mary's and all children will get an opportunity to meet a variety of animals such as Geckos and Giant Snails. This has been funded by the PTA and I would like to extend my thanks to the PTA for providing this wonderful experience.

On Tuesday 5th May at 1pm - 3.30pm an Early Help support worker will be in school, should you like any support or advice on any element of family life. Please let us know if you would like an appointment.

Wednesday 22nd April is 'Earth Day', to recognise this the Eco-council has organised a walk to school. Please meet us at the 'The Carousel' at 8.30am or walk, scoot or cycle from home.
